New Flag Program

As a result of a member asking if Post 233 had a program to retire special flags such as those presented to the family at military funerals, we are going to develop such a program in the near future. After discussions with the Commander and a few members, here is what is being proposed.

If you are in possession of an American flag that has been draped on a veteran's casket and for whatever reason you no longer can keep it, don't want to keep it, or have no one to pass it on to, Post 233 will give it a proper retirement. If such a flag is in good enough condition, we will fly it on the Post flagpole and so note the veteran's name and military information in a proper place, at the Post home while it is being flown. Also, if a family member of a deceased Post 233 member would like to donate a new flag to be flown at the Post in honor of a deceased member, this could be done and the flag would also be retired in an appropriate manner.
