

MISSING IN AMERICA PROJECT UPDATE (MIAP)

Kathy Church, MIAP – FL State Coordinator

I will be sending out an MIAP update in the bulletin on a regular basis. MIAP is an American Legion endorsed Project (Resolution 24). Our Mission is to work with funeral homes, locate identify & inter the forgotten remains of Veterans, spouses & dependents of Veterans. Currently we are the only organization working with the DVA that the Government is allowing us to do this work.

To date MIAP –Jacksonville has held three full military services at the National Cemetery, Jax for an USAF, USN & a USMC Veteran. It is fitting and proper for us to do this for these Veterans as they deserve to have a final resting place in our National Cemeteries.

MIAP is a non-profit 501 (3) (C), Inc organization and works solely on donations and with the dedication of hard working volunteers. If you would like to become a supporter or volunteer please go to our website @ www.miap.us or to our Facebook Page @ MIAP – Florida. You can also contact me or our Auxiliary 1st Vice, Linda Williams, about this project.

Here is the current summary of Veterans that we have located in just two funeral homes here in Jacksonville. All are awaiting burial. MIAP is currently working to get House Bill #171 & Senate Bill #370 amended which involves a "Release of Liability" law. Once these are passed we will move forward and hold services for all Veterans that we have located.
