
# E-Board Member/ Planning Cmte./ Service Officer - Maury Lazenby

Larry Sheets, Department Judge Advocate, has reminded all Florida posts with bylaw changes to submit updates. Currently there is a fifteen day turnaround on approvals. Bylaws without changes may be updated with a cover letter, copy of same attached, to comply with the three year rule. Also, post elections should be on target for nominations and voting scheduled for May, 2014.

The Defense Department has issued a scam alert for all Army soldiers, retirees, family members and Army civilians on a website called "My Army Benefits". This is nearly identical to the official Army website "MyArmyBenefits" (no spacing betwen words). The phony site is collecting Army Knowledge Online or AKO, email accounts and passwords. It also claims to grant access to unclaimed and accumulated benefits for active duty solders. DOD advises not to log in to this phony site and delete suspicious emails immediately.
