


Hello Everyone,



MIAP - FL - May 2014

I would like to take a moment to thank the American Legion 5th District for the Special Award that was presented to me at the 5th District Constitutional Conference on Sunday, April 27th. This award has my name on it but MIAP – FL would not be able to accomplish what we have in the past three years if not for all the dedicated volunteers we have on board. This award goes to all of us. The support we have been getting from the American Legion family throughout the 5th District has also been amazing and very much appreciated.

On Friday, June 27, 2014 @ 1pm MIAP - FL will hold "Call to Honor" #3 at the Jacksonville National Cemetery. Currently we will be interring 16 veterans and 4 spouses. Included in this service is a USMC WWII veteran and his spouse. They died within ten days of each other in 1991. Also included are veterans from the Army, Marine Corp, Navy, Air Force, Army National Guard and Merchant Marine. Several of these "forgotten heroes" have sat on funeral home shelves dating back to 1970. They are veterans of WWI, WWII, Korea and Vietnam.

As always we invite all members of the American Legion family to participate in or attend this service. ALR riders and any rider organization are invited to join the JSO in the escorting of the hearse to the cemetery. I will keep everyone posted on this service as the plans come together.

These donations help us with sending out registered letters to last known next of kin, newspaper notices, insurance for volunteers and escort riders, administration fees, vendor table set up and displays and other things of this nature.
