MISSING IN AMERICA PROJECT

VETERAN RECOVERY PROGRAM



I would like to inform our members and readers about MIAP.

The mission of the MIAP is to locate, identify and inter the unclaimed remated remains of veterans through the joint efforts of private, state and federal organizations:

to provide honor and respect to those who have served this country, by securing a final resting place for these forgotten heroes. MIAP is a 501(c) (3) Non-profit organization.

History of MIAP

During an inventory of a crematorium, two cremation urns were discovered in a closet facility. The urns contained the unclaimed remains of Sgt. Trueman, a veteran of the Vietnam conflict and his wife (also a veteran). The year of the death for Stg. Trueman was 1979. For 27 years the resting place for Sgt. and Mrs. Trueman was a storage facility in a crematorium. Other funeral homes and crematoriums were inventoried. Other unclaimed remains of veterans were discovered. In Nov. 2006, the Idaho State Veterans Cemetery interred 21 cremated remains of forgotten veterans, with full military honors and the dignity these fallen heroes so richly deserve. This incident inspired and started the MIAP.

CURRENT INFO

I am currently in training as Asst. to the Asst State Coordinator - Florida Bob Morgan. We are currently working the Hardage Giddens funeral home on Beach Blvd.

Out of 12 funeral homes stored in one shed there are over 500 unclaimed cremains. To date we have verified 43 and are waiting to do a service at the Jacksonville Veterans Cemetery on Memorial Day in May 2013. Just recently over 2,220 unclaimed cremains were located in a city in New York, which volunteers are currently working. We need more volunteers who can do file research, fund raising and funeral home contacting. Here in Jacksonville we held a service for Clarence Hill who was an Air Force Veteran whose cremains were found in a closed down nursing home.

I have set a personal goal to raise \$1,000.00 in donations for MIAP. I would like to thank the Post 233 Legion, Auxiliary, SAL and Auxiliary member, Karen O'Neill for their donations totaling \$400.00. Donations are used for the following:

Postage for registered letters to next of kin
Death Certificates
Burial permits
Accounting
Expenses including Insurance to National
Long Escort Rides
